



## Contacting You Via Your Cell Phone Number or Email Address

In order to discuss your potential employment with Navy Federal, you must provide us with a phone number or an email address. If you provide a cell phone number, Navy Federal has your permission to contact you at that number about potential Navy Federal employment. You're granting Navy Federal permission to place automated, prerecorded or artificial-voice non-marketing calls and text messages to that number. Messaging and data rates from your carrier may apply. If you provide an email address, Navy Federal has your permission to send you email messages using an automatic emailing system to provide status updates on potential Navy Federal employment.
