Navy Federal Opens Branch in Colo.

New branch is located three miles from Fort Carson.

VIENNA, Va. (Sept. 22, 2011) – On Monday, Sept. 26 [Navy Federal Credit Union](http://navyfederal.org) will open its newest branch near Fort Carson, Colo. to serve 66,500 Department of Defense personnel and their families. Fort Carson is home to the 4th Infantry Division; 43rd Sustainment Brigade; 10th Special Forces Group; 1st Squadron, 6th Cavalry Regiment; 71st Ordnance Group; 1st Battalion, 2nd Aviation Regiment, 2nd Infantry Division.

The new branch is located at 6916 Mesa Ridge Parkway. The 2,450 square foot building is located in the Markets of Mesa Ridge, approximately three miles from Gate 20. Lobby hours of operation are Monday through Friday 9 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.; Saturday 9 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. The branch has one full-service ATM.
