Navy Federal Celebrates Grand Opening of Relocated Altamonte Springs Branch with City Mayor

Altamonte Springs, Fla. (August 22, 2013) – [Navy Federal Credit Union](http://www.navyfederal.org) celebrated yesterday the grand opening of its relocated Altamonte Springs branch, hosting Altamonte Springs Mayor Pat Bates. In addition, the Veterans of Foreign Wars Apopka/Altamonte Springs Chapter was in attendance to raise the branch's new flag, presented by local representatives of Woodmen of the World.

“This branch will make things more convenient for our members in every possible way,” said Debbie Wilson, Navy Federal Altamonte Springs branch manager. “Not only is the branch easier to find and more centrally located than our previous site, but it’s bigger too. We’re excited to be able to serve our members even more effectively in this larger location.”

In addition to the opening remarks and ceremonies, the branch offered a special promotion beginning on the grand opening date. Any retired or active duty military personnel to open a direct deposit checking account while at the branch received a \$100 Navy Federal gift card. The promotion remains in effect until the end of August.

Just over a mile from the old site, the new branch is located at 955 W. State Road 436, Suite 1060, in the Altamonte Springs Wekiva Shopping Plaza. The new location includes a coin machine and a walk-up scan ATM.

Branch lobby hours are Monday - Thursday, 9 a.m. - 5:30 p.m., Friday 9 a.m. - 6 p.m., and Saturday 9 a.m. - 1 p.m.
