Navy Federal's Service Culture Claims Second Consecutive Win as One of Hawaii's 2013 Best Places to Work

The worldwide credit union, serving the U.S. armed forces and their families, has three of its 229 branches located in Hawaii. *The Best Places to Work* award recognizes the employee-centric Hawaii-area businesses that empower, excite and challenge their staff.

In addition to being selected in the small company category (fewer than 50 employees working in Hawaii), the credit union also received two Editor's Choice Awards for Healthiest Workplaces and Most Family-Friendly Companies. "We consider it an honor to provide service to over 72,000 members in the Hawaii area," commented Maria White-Marchus, regional manager, Branch Operations. "Navy Federal goes above and beyond for its employees, and, in turn we serve our members with that same level of dedication every day."

Some of the credit union's employee-centric programs include recognition programs for employees who exceed performance goals, flexible working schedules, wellness and fitness programs, and annual leave bank donations to help employees who face a serious injury or illness or a catastrophic event that has exhausted their own leave.

All of the organizations considered for the *Best Places to Work in Hawaii 2013* must employ at least 15 workers in Hawaii and have been in operation at least one year. They complete a rigorous two-part survey process. The first part includes an evaluation of each company's workplace policies, philosophy and demographics. The second portion includes an employee survey measuring employee satisfaction. The combined scores determine the top companies and the final ranking.
