Navy Federal Names New Chief Information Officer

VIENNA, Va. (June 3, 2019)— Today [Navy Federal Credit Union](#) announced the promotion of Anthony “Tony” Gallardy to serve as the new Executive Vice President and Chief Information Officer. Gallardy is taking the reins from Bill Hills, who is retiring after nearly a decade of service with the credit union.
