Recognition Highlights Work on Behalf of Credit Union Movement

VIENNA, Va. Each year, NAFCU recognizes a credit union advocate for their grassroots and political efforts on behalf of the credit union movement.

"Credit unions' mission of serving their members and local communities is unparalleled in financial services, and I am proud to support our cooperative, not-for-profit industry. The award was presented at NAFCU's annual Congressional Caucus.

To be considered for the Paul Revere Award, candidates must have:

- worked at a NAFCU-member credit union;
- held at least two meetings during 2019 or 2020 with each of their members of Congress (two senators and one representative);
- responded to all NAFCU Grassroots Alerts by completing the actions requested, such as phone calls, emails and letters to their lawmakers; and
- remained in regular contact with NAFCU for the most up-to-date legislative and regulatory information.
